Motion to Approve the Name Change of Station 42 to Thomas L. "Tom" Threadgill Fire Station

Summary:

Sandoval County Commissioners created a Facility Naming Committee to honor individuals with dedication and/or naming certain facilities. This committee consists of seven (7) members: 5 members from the public representing each Commission district; 1 elected official - Eileen Garbagni and 1 staff member - Tommy Mora, Jr. On July 24, 2013 three (3) members were able to attend and hear a presentation from Fire Chief James Maxon and District Chief Humberto Macias. The Committee recommends to the Commission that Fire Station #42 be re-named Thomas L. "Tom" Threadgill Fire Station.

The Committee meeting held on July 24, 2013 was called to order at 4:20 p.m. by Public Works Interim Director Tommy Mora.

Present were: Tommy Mora, Public Works Interim Director, Fire Chief James Maxon, District Chief Humberto Macias, Cippy Montoya District 1, Bob Guido Rio Rancho District 4, .

The Board of County Commissioners have appointed a Committee for the naming of County Public Buildings or Interior Features, Facilities, Public Places or Natural Features Policy.

That Committee consists of (7) members (5) members from the public representing each Commission district and (1) elected Official and (1) staff member.

Mr. Tommy Mora, briefed on the establishing of the resolution passed on November 22, 2012 by the Board of County Commissioners at a regular Commission Meeting.

Fire Chief James Maxon and District Chief Humberto Macias gave a presentation on the history of how the Placitas Volunteer Fire Department came to be and recommended that Fire Station 42 be renamed after one of the original founders. The recommendation is to rename the station as the Thomas L. "Tom" Threadgill Fire Station.

Cippy Montoya spoke about Mr. Threadgill's character and what a fine person he was.

A motion was then made to recommend the approval of the name changes and was passed without any objection.
