Professional Services Agreement Amendment One with Regents of the University of New Mexico, UNM Medical Group, Inc., for the Provision of Oral Health Prevention Services

Action Requested:

Motion to Approve Professional Services Agreement Amendment One between Sandoval County and the Regents of the University of New Mexico, UNM Medical Group, Inc., for the Provision of Oral Health Prevention Services beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014.

Summary:

This contract provides the Oral Health Program with a Dentist 8 hours per month and a Dental Hygienist 16 hours per week. It also provides billing of all Medicaid clients seen by the Dentist and Dental Hygienist. The dollars collected from Medicaid are then paid to Sandoval County to help fund this program.

Amendment No. 1 makes the following changes to the contract:

1. It reduces the number of dentist hours per month from 16 to 8.
2. It changes the monthly compensation from \$5,224 to \$5,600/month.
3. It extends the term of the contract to 6/30/14
4. It replaces the Medicaid payment schedule for Medicaid payments made to the County.

**AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE
TO THE
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
AMONG
THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO,
UNM MEDICAL GROUP, INC.
AND
SANDOVAL COUNTY**

This Amendment Number One (this "Amendment") amends the Professional Services Agreement entered into on July 1, 2012 by and among the Regents of the University of New Mexico, for its public operation known as the Health Sciences Center, specifically for the Department of Dental Medicine ("UNMHSC"), UNM Medical Group, Inc., a New Mexico non-profit and University Research Park and Economic Development act corporation ("UNMMG"), and the County of Sandoval, a political subdivision of the State of New Mexico ("COUNTY").

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF UNMHSC. Section I. A. of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:

A. UNMHSC will supply the services of a dentist ("UNMHSC Dentist") eight (8) hours per month and a dental hygienist ("UNMHSC Hygienist") sixteen (16) hours per week to provide professional dental services to patients of the County at the Health Commons Facility.

II. COMPENSATION. Section V. E. of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:

E. The COUNTY will pay UNMMG for professional dental services provided by the UNMHSC Dentist and the UNMHSC Hygienist, for administrative fees, including but not limited to the cost of billing and collections, and for training of COUNTY personnel, in the amount of five thousand six hundred dollars (\$5,600.00) per month.

III. TERM. Subject to the conditions set forth in Section V.A. of the Agreement as to early termination, the term of the Agreement is hereby extended through June 30, 2014.

IV. EXHIBIT A. Exhibit A of the Agreement is hereby replaced in its entirety with the attached Exhibit A.

V. **CONTINUING EFFECT.** Except as modified by this Amendment, the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
