“INTEL EMPLOYEES Recognition as Community Heroes”

This proclamation is in recognition of the community involvement and contributions of the Intel employees to the communities of Sandoval County.

Whereas, since 1980 when Intel Corporation first located in Sandoval County and now has operated their manufacturing facilities here for the past thirty-three years; and

Whereas, in the last thirty-three years Intel employees and the Intel Foundation have contributed over \$34 million to the United Way of Central New Mexico; and

Whereas, Intel employees have volunteered nearly 500,000 hours of their time in the community and those employee volunteer hours have been matched by grants from the Intel Foundation totaling more than \$2.6 million to benefit local schools and community-based non-profit organizations; and

Whereas, during the Holiday Season each year, Intel employees adopt hundreds of families in Sandoval County delivering food and presents to many individuals, this last year there were more than 250 families adopted and food and presents provided for more than 1,000 individuals; and

Whereas, in previous years Intel employees have purchased, filled, and delivered school backpacks complete with all the required school supplies, enough for every student in the benefitted area, for example in 2012 and 2013 Intel employees delivered 250 backpacks each year for every student of the Jemez Valley Elementary and Middle schools; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners is proud and honored to have the opportunity to recognize the kind and generous community contribution of the Intel employees to the citizens of Sandoval County.
