RESOLUTION NO. 10-24-13.4A

CREATION OF PRECINCT 77

AT THE PUEBLO OF JEMEZ

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Election Code, Article 3, §1-3-2A NMSA (1978) empowers the Board of County Commissioners to create and designate precincts and polling locations; and

WHEREAS, the current and former Governors of the Pueblo of Jemez have requested a new precinct be created by splitting the current Precinct 15 into two precincts; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with NMSA 1978, §4-38-21, the County was presented with petitions requesting the creation of a new precinct within the boundaries of Precinct 15; and

WHEREAS, the proposed new precinct (Precinct 77) contained 680 registered voters; and

WHEREAS, seventy-one (71) registered voters from the proposed new precinct (Precinct 77) signed the petition, thereby satisfying the requirements of §4-38-21 (10% of registered voters); and

WHEREAS, the newly delineated Precinct 15 and proposed Precinct 77 are compact in form and cover as small an area as practicable and, furthermore, their boundaries comply with the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act and serve the greatest convenience of the voters therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sandoval County Board of County Commissioners does hereby endorse and approve the new precinct, "Precinct 77" at the Pueblo of Jemez and create a new boundary for Precinct 15 as depicted in Attachment "A" and described in Attachment "B".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified and duly recorded copy of this Resolution and attachments be forwarded to the Secretary of State's Office as provided by NMSA §1-3-1 (1978).
