

**SANDOVAL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**REGULAR MEETING MINUTES**  
**COMMISSION CHAMBERS**  
**NOVEMBER 6, 2014 – 6 P.M.**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Madalena called meeting to order at 6:02p.m. Present were Chairman Madalena, Vice Chairman Lucero, Commissioner Scherzinger, Commissioner Chapman and Commissioner Walters.
