

GOVERNING BOARD RESOLUTION 2016-80
RESOLUTION AND PROCLAMATION
OF CENTRAL NEWMEXICO COMMUNITY COLLEGE
BOARD MEMBER ELECTION

A RESOLUTION AND PROCLAMATION CALLING FOR THE CENTRAL NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE COUNTIES OF BERNALILLO AND SANDOVAL, IN THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO, ON FEBRUARY 7, 2017 FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING TO ELECT BOARD MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Board (the "Board") of the Central New Mexico Community College District (the "District") established under the laws of New Mexico in 1965 and pursuant to Sections 21-13-1 through 21-13-26 NMSA 1978, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that an election to elect Board Members, (the "Election") shall be held Tuesday, February 7, 2017, and that a Resolution and Proclamation of the Election shall be issued by the Board, in accordance with Section 1-22-4, NMSA 1978; and

WHEREAS, the Rio Rancho School District is holding its school district election on February 7, 2017 and has selected voting sites for that election; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined to use the same voting sites for the 2017 election as are used by the Rio Rancho School District which are hereinafter included in the Polling Site Locations; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 1-22-4, NMSA 1978, an election shall be held, and a Resolution and Proclamation of the Election shall be issued by the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CENTRAL NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY COLLEGE, COUNTIES OF BERNALILLO AND SANDOVAL, STATE OF NEW MEXICO THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION AND PROCLAMATION BE AND IT HEREBY IS ISSUED:

PROCLAMATION

Section 1. An election is hereby called to be held in the Central New Mexico Community College District (the "District") on February 7, 2017, for the purpose of electing five members who live within the District to the Governing Board of Central New Mexico Community College. Four positions are to be filled at the election, designated as positions 1, 3, 5, and 7, and are for a four-year term. One position is to be filled at the election designated as position 4, and is for a two-year term.

Section 2. The election to elect board members, for the Central New Mexico Community College District, Counties of Bernalillo and Sandoval, New Mexico (the "District") shall be held on Tuesday, February 7, 2017.

Section 3. Four (4) persons shall be elected to the Board of the District for a full term of four (4) years from single-member districts within the District, and the positions to be filled are respectively designated Position 1 (District 1), Position 3 (District 3), Position 5 (District 5), and Position 7 (District 7). One (1) person shall be elected to the Board of the District for a two (2) year term from a single-member district within the District and the position to be filled is Position 4 (District 4).

Section 4. Each elector of District 1 within the District will be entitled to vote for one candidate for Position 1; each elector of District 3 within the District will be entitled to vote for one candidate for Position 3, each elector of District 4 within the District will be entitled to vote for one candidate for Position 4; each elector of District 5 within the District will be entitled to vote for one candidate for Position 5; and each elector of District 7 within the District will be entitled to vote for one candidate for Position 7. The candidate receiving the greatest number of votes for Position 1 shall be elected to Position 1; the candidate with the greatest number of votes for Position 3 will be elected to Position 3, the candidate with the greatest number of votes for Position 4 will be elected to Position 4; the candidate with the greatest number of votes for Position 5 will be elected to Position 5; and the candidate with the greatest number of votes for Position 7 will be elected to Position 7.

Section 5. Declarations of candidacy and a sworn statement of intent are to be filed with the County Clerk of Bernalillo County, Albuquerque, New Mexico, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., on December 20, 2016.

Section 6. Affidavits of withdrawal of candidacy or declarations of intent to be a write-in candidate are to be filed with the County Clerk of Bernalillo County before 5:00 p.m. on January 3, 2017.

Section 7. The following Voting Convenience Centers will be used for this election. In accordance with 1-3-4D NMSA, 1978, each Voting Convenience Center contains a consolidation of precincts, not to exceed ten precincts. The Voting Convenience Centers may be utilized by any eligible voter of the District on Election Day.

POLLING LOCATIONS FEBRUARY 7, 2017 ELECTION

For purposes of absentee voting all of the Districts are consolidated into one single precinct and the location of the polling place for such absent voter precinct is the office of the County Clerk of Bernalillo County, One Civic Plaza, 6th Floor, Albuquerque, New Mexico. Absentee voting will be permitted as authorized by Section 1-22-19 NMSA 1978, and the Absent Voter Act of the Election Code, Sections 1-6-1 through 1-6-18, NMSA 1978. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained from the office of the County Clerk of Bernalillo County, One Civic Plaza, 6th Floor, Albuquerque, New Mexico. Completed applications must be returned before 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 3, 2017, which is the last day to mail out ballots. Absentee ballots of District voters may be marked in person at the office of the County Clerk of Bernalillo County, 111 Union Square SE, Albuquerque, New Mexico, or delivered to the County Clerk from Friday, January 13, 2017 at 8:00 a.m. until Friday, February 3, 2017, at 5:00 p.m. Sealed envelopes containing marked absentee ballots of District voters will be received by the County Clerk of Bernalillo County until 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 7, 2017.

The polling places will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on election day, Tuesday, February 7, 2017.

Section 8. The County Clerk of Bernalillo County, New Mexico, is required by law to close the registration books for the election at 5:00 p.m., on Tuesday, January 10, 2017, and a person will be allowed to vote only if he or she is an elector of the District and currently registered to vote in the District at that time. Any qualified elector of the District who is not now registered and who wishes to vote at the election should register during regular office hours at the office of the County Clerk of Bernalillo County, One Civic Plaza, 6th Floor, Albuquerque, New Mexico, or with any registration agent at a designated agency as provided in Sections 1-4-47 and 1-4-48, NMSA 1978, prior to 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 10, 2017. For federal qualified electors and overseas voters, the County Clerk shall accept a certificate of registration by electronic transmission from a voter qualified to apply for and vote by absentee ballot in the District if the transmission is received before 5:00 p.m. on February 3, 2017, the Friday immediately preceding the election.

END OF PROCLAMATION

Section 9. The foregoing Proclamation shall be used for required publications.

Section 10. In the event that only one candidate has filed a declaration of candidacy for each position to be filled at the election, no declared write-ins have filed for any position and there are no questions or bond issues on the ballot, only one polling place for the election shall be designated and it shall be in the office of the county clerk or a designated polling place in the District of the county in which the District is located.

Section 11. The casting of votes by qualified electors at the polling places, including the Absentee polling place, shall be cast on a paper ballot to be tabulated on a voting system authorized under Section 1-9-1, *et. seq.*, NMSA 1978. The paper ballots

shall be tabulated using Image Cast Evolution. A complete sample ballot, in English and Spanish, shall be placed near the voting machines in plain view of the qualified voters so that the complete ballot may be examined before they vote.

Section 12. The Proclamation shall be published in full in English and Spanish, one time not less than fifty (50) days prior to such election, i.e. prior to Monday, December 2, 2016. All such publications shall be in the *Albuquerque Journal* being the legal newspaper having a general circulation within the District. The Bernalillo County Clerk is directed to publish the Proclamation as provided above.

Section 13. The Proclamation with the names of the precinct board members shall be published in English and Spanish once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks, with the last publication being made within seven (7) days but not later than two (2) days before the date of the election.

Section 14. The vote shall be canvassed as provided in Section 1-22-15, NMSA 1978, and the County Clerk shall certify the results of the Election and cause the results of the election to be published once in the *Albuquerque Journal*, a newspaper of general circulation in the District.

Section 15. A sample ballot, in English and Spanish, shall be placed near the voting machines in plain view of the qualified voters so that a ballot may be examined before they vote.

Section 16. The County Clerk of Bernalillo County is requested to conduct the election in accordance with this resolution as provided by Section 1-22-1 et seq., NMSA 1978, the New Mexico Election Code, the Federal Voting Rights Act, including but not necessarily limited to, making available at the offices of the Clerk of Bernalillo County, and at the appropriate polling places (by being present or on call), Spanish-speaking persons who are fluent in reading, writing and speaking English or persons who are fluent in speaking other minority languages used in the District who are fluent in reading, writing and speaking English.

Section 17. The Board reserves the right to change the voting locations previously adopted by the Board if such amendment serves the best interest of the District.

Section 18. The Chair and the officers of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution and Proclamation.

Section 19. All action heretofore taken by the Board, the President and officers of the District not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution and the aforesaid Election Resolution and Proclamation directed toward the calling and conducting of the election be, and the same hereby is ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 20. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section 21. All acts, motions or resolutions, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency.




