1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Heil called the meeting to order at 2:00pm. Present were Chair Heil, Vice Chair Meek, Commissioner Jones and Commissioner Block via telecommunications.

2. Conclude Canvass of Results of the 2024 Runoff Election results for the City of Rio Rancho.

Rebecca Martinez, City Clerk for the City of Rio Rancho, discussed the canvass report for regular municipal officer election. The City Charter requires that a candidate be elected by a majority of the vote vs the plurality of the vote. Two of the City Council Districts, City Council District 1 and District 6 in the regular election did not receive the majority of the votes cast. They were required to conduct a runoff election on April 9,2024. Rebecca provided the official canvass to the Board of Commissioners.

Commissioner Jones made a motion to approve, seconded by Vice Chair Meek. Commissioner Block, Vice Chair Meek, Commissioner Jones and Chair Heil, voted yes. Motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Block provided his approval for the usage of electronic signatures.

Commissioner Jones made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Vice Chair Meek, meeting adjourned at 2:06P.M.


