The County does not anticipate future inmate growth.

There are five (5) vendor employees.

Annual background checks are conducted by the Detention Center at no cost to the vendor.

The microwaves are commercial grade and in 13 pods. The Detention Center requires 2 microwaves.

 - ii. Will the entire kitchen be closed down during this process? **Yes.**

- iii. How long is it expected that the remodel occur? **30 days.**
 - iv. Will trustees still be permitted to support the vendor staff in food preparation/traying of meals? **No.**
 - v. Is it expected that the vendor provide a satellite kitchen/equipment for continued meal service? **Yes, a satellite kitchen.**
 - vi. Will this renovation interfere with food supplies being delivered? **Must be delivered to a refrigerated trailer.**
 - vii. If Styrofoam is to be used as a means of food service delivery to inmates, who will be paying for the Styrofoam (the County or the vendor)? **The County.**
- b. The kitchen equipment is expected to be 100% switched out with new equipment targeting Mid-Year 2025 –

 - ii. Would the County please clarify exactly what equipment is being replaced (i.e. Trays, carts, mixers, walk-in fridge/freezer, etc.)? **Kettle, dishwasher, stoves, mixers, ovens, ice machine.**
 - iii. Does the County have an approach where equipment will be a phased in approach or will the kitchen be closed down completely? **Phased – the County will leave the kitchen operational during this time.**
 - iv. How long will the equipment update take? **We are anticipating two (2) weeks.**
 - v. What capacity will trustees be able to support kitchen operations? **Preparation of foods, serving for trays, clean up. No cooking.**
 - vi. Will the vendor be expected to provide a satellite kitchen/equipment for continued meal service? **Yes.**
 - vii. Will the vendor still be able to accept normal food supply deliveries? **Yes.**
 - viii. If Styrofoam is to be used as a means of food service delivery to inmates who will be paying for the Styrofoam (the County or the vendor)? **The County.**


