

FACILITY REGISTRATION PACKAGE - "CHECK LIST"

- I. 1. An area map and site plan of the proposed facility was provided with the registration form. The document was prepared by Molzen-Corbin and Associates, Sandoval County contract engineers and details the contract agreement with Laguna Construction and site specifications.
- 2. Rural/unincorporated zoning applicable to Sandoval County. Transfer site for Cuba is within the existing Sandoval County Road Yard.
- II. An operating plan:
- 1. Daily dumping of solid waste at the Sandoval County Landfill, tarping of containers and continued spraying of containers.
- 2. Anticipated start-up date is anticipated and scheduled for: Cuba Transfer Station 1-17-95

Schedule of Operation - 2 days per wk. 20 hrs., 8-5

Canon Transfer Station - same operation schedule & start-up date

Pena Blanca Transfer Station 2-6-95

2 days per wk 20 hrs. operation

Landfill Convience Station 3

3-6-95 3 days per wk 30 hrs. operation

- 3. Alternative waste handing would be contracted with private sector: MCT Inc., Bedford, Southwest Services, and Seay Bros., Inc.
- 4. Procedures will be taken by Sandoval County to ensure, that as owner/operator all resources within County disposal will be utilized. Additional resources would include the contracting with private enterprise.
- 5. Origin would include geographic area within the County of Sandoval and those in proximity to each transfer site. Sandoval County has purchased seven (7) 40 cubic yard, roll-off, bath tube style containers with tractor. Each station will be accepting materials from the solid waste

stream not to exceed 40 cubic yards per container. Start-up program for recyclables will be in collaboration with the stations. Materials accepted will include; tin, newsprint, plastics, cardboard and aluminum.

- 6. Approximately, 6 cubic yards of recyclable materials are predicted for the initial start-up program.
- 7. It has been estimated that approximately 80 cubic yards of solid waste will be transported from each station per week with the exception of the site located at the Sandoval County Landfill which is estimated at approximately 160 cubic yards of solid waste within a permitted landfill. Expected life of each facility will be 20 years.
- 8. Number, type and size of equipment will include: Cuba 2-40 yd. containers
 Canon 2-40 yd. containers
 Pena Blanca 2-40 yd containers
 Sandoval County Landfill 4-40 yd containers
 Recycling Trailer 1-12 yd
